Lancaster is ideally placed on the M6 whether traveling from the north, Jnct 34, or the south, Jnct 33, both less than 15 minutes from car parks close to the Hall, £1.50 after 6pm or free in Dalton Square or Robert Street if you are early enough to find a space. The Satnav for the Town Hall is LA1 1PJ.

NICOL MCLAREN and THE GLENCRAIG SCOTTISH DANCE BAND will play us into the first half of the programme with a Grand March. There are twelve dances before supper is served at approximately 9.00pm and eight afterwards, finishing before 11.30pm. We hope you will stay for the whole programme.

As last year, you are invited to nominate who you wish to be seated with but it is not obligatory! Tables seat ten but whatever size your party we will put you together. Please indicate on the ticket application and we will add you to the table plan but please stick to it. We will provide water on the table and you may bring your own drinks if you wish. Vegetarian or other special meals will be made to order only. Please make sure that you complete the section on the ticket applications, they are not available on the day as an alternative. Please speak to one of the waiting staff in the dining room if you have a special order.
