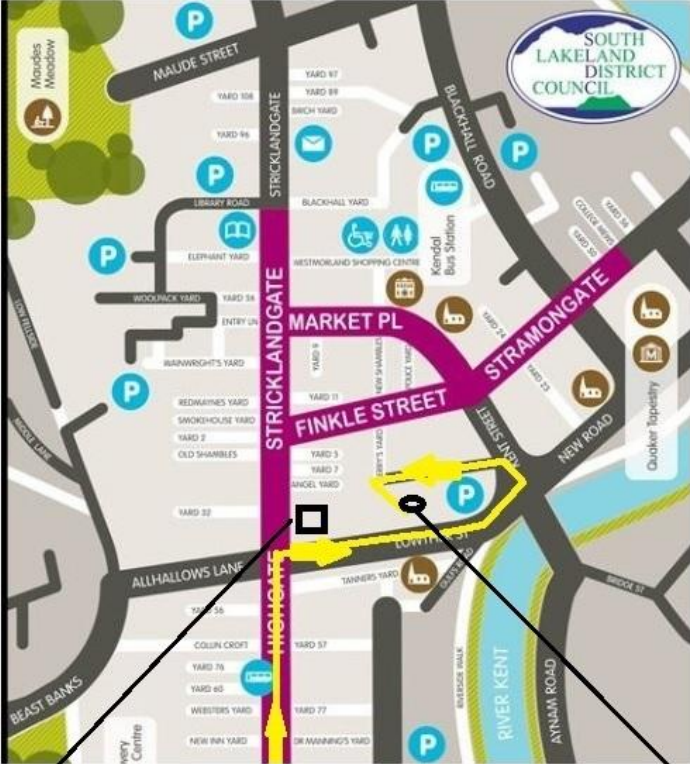

### Directions to Town Hall and Car Park

There are number of parking facilities in Kendal town centre and those familiar with Kendal and its infamous one-way system will be able to choose their favourite place. For those new to Kendal we would recommend the parking area shown on the map here. It is cheap to park on Sunday with an all-day ticket costing £1.00.

Enter Kendal from the South along Highgate (one way) up to the main "Town Hall" traffic lights. The entrance to the Town Hall is on the NE corner at this junction. Turn right at the traffic lights down Lowther Street. Immediately after the pedestrian crossing, at the bottom of the hill, turn left into Kent Street and immediately left again up the hill. The parking area nearest the hall is on the roof of the underground car park on the left-hand side. Look out for our signs and balloons.
