Directions to Town Hall and Car Park

There are a number of parking facilities in Kendal town centre and those familiar with Kendal and its infamous one-way system will be able to choose their favourite place. For those new to Kendal we would recommend the parking area shown on the map here.

Enter Kendal from the South along Highgate (one way) up to the "Town Hall" traffic lights. The entrance to the Town Hall is on the NE corner at this junction. For parking, turn right at the traffic lights down lowther street. Immediately after the pedestrian crossing, at the bottom of the hill, turn left into Kent Street and immediately left again up the hill. The parking area is on the roof of the underground car park (do not enter the underground parking area as it will be locked later). Look out for our signs and ballons.

Useful information:

Nearest mainline station – Oxenholme, Lake District. There are nearly always taxis waiting at the station on the eastern side entrance

Kendal Town Hall post code: LA9 4DL

Rooftop parking area behind the Town Hall: If you are using a Sat Nav then LA9 4AY will take you to the turning off Kent Street up to the car parking area (it is for MacBeth Scott on the corner of Kent Street and the car-park road)
